REPORT ON THE PROCEEDINGS:

A great day's sport was had by all at the Final of the TRI Equestrian Interschools Ireland league last Sunday. There was a large range of events on offer for primary and secondary pupils held in three arenas in Mullingar Equestrian Centre.

The main events were held in the new International arena and were very well supported as were all the other competitions. Robert Fagan and Seamus Dermody built a full height track for the open competitors. First event of the day was the open team event. This produced an exciting jump off involving eight of the twenty two teams entered. The trip from Galway proved worthwhile for the mixed team of Presentation Athenry and Presentation Tuam as they saw off determined opposition to claim the competition. Conan Mc Cann and Lurgan King, Colourful Shannon and Jack Neilan and Star Appraisal ridden by Jack Naughton from Athenry were joined by Dexter Prance and Anna Mooney from Presentation Tuam to complete the team. This win has earned them free transport to Hickstead for the Hurstpierpoint Interschools Championship in July. Maynooth Community School represented by Ellen Murphy on Blank Cheque, Zoe Power and Fionn Sceal, Emma Egan riding Argus and Theo Can Cauwenberge (Quantum Quest) claimed second place ahead of Mercy Kilbeggan in third. Lauren Carroll riding Mallmore Bobby, Roisin Mealiffe and Caherina Swift, Woodview Prince ridden by Caitlin Glennon and Meadhbh Mealiffe and Tirnaskea Graffa Master made up the Kilbeggan team. Taking the minor places were Colaiste bride carnew, Wesley College and Newbridge Integrated from Banbridge Co. Down.

League.

Extra points are awarded in the league final and Colaiste Bride's fourth place was enough to rocket them up the league placings to claim the league from long time league leaders Newbridge College by a single point. Claiming third place in the league was Wesley College ahead of Gorey Community School, Maynooth Community School and Presentation Athenry. Borris Vocational School and Newbridge College were joint winners of the turnout league.

Open Individual

The open individual event with sixty entries produced some superb riding against the clock, but no one could match the time posted by current league leader Daniel Fitzgerald from Newbridge College. Fitzgerald was riding Another Dooley. J Naughton representing Presentation Athenry riding Emerald Star claimed second place ahead of Conor Weafer of Colaiste Bride riding Knockbawn Lady. Caitriona Dowley on Garry Fine Cross was fourth with Kirsti Connole in fifth and Nicole Dalton in sixth. Fitzgerald's win secured his position at the head of the League with quite a point's distance to his nearest rival, Nora Fay. Rachel Ross was third with Caragh Sweeney in fourth, Pippa Durham in fifth and Hugh McOwan in sixth place.

110 class.

The last class in the International Arena was the final of the HSI sponsored 110 premier league. This attracted over 30 entries from qualified combinations. Whilst double clear rounds were hard to come by J Naughton on Star Appraisal gave it his all to claim the win ahead of Caragh Sweeney riding Kippure Steepleview Jack and Cathal Duffy on Ballyengland Regal. Fourth place went to Lucia Merrigan riding Flash Molly. J Naughton was fifth on his second mount, Emerald Star, as the fastest four faulter with open league winner Daniel Fitzgerald riding Erbes Corvette in sixth.

The league winners and the 110 winner received a HSI bursary for a day's training at the national sports campus in Abbotstown as well as very generous prizes from TRI and Equestrian Interschools Ireland.

Meanwhile in the other arenas the primary schools stars of the future had an exciting time with honours going to **Kildangan NS**. Tina ridden by Christine Worrell, Harry ridden by Ella Kelly, Bullseye and Joshua Halford and Filco partnered by Tommy Halford made up the team. Prior to this the 50cm event went to Firebee (Nicole Brennan) / Dalystown NS and the 60cm to Archill Lass (Emma Burns) Holy Faith NS

The Novice team event and Mullingar Perpetual Trophy was won by The Teresian School from Dublin. The team consisted of The Caherview Boy and Anna Corless, Ballymore Lad ridden by Sophie Roden, Kiltewan Rover and Isobelle Nulty and Oileann Arann Cailin with Anna Byrne. Calasanctius College Oranmore was second with the trip from the north proving worthwhile for Ballymena Academy who finished in third place.
