It was a TRI double victory for Borris Vocational School at the TRI Interschools event held at JAG Equestrian last Saturday. Their team claimed victory against strong opposition in the TRI Open team event and team member Cathy Doyle on Boley boy was also victorious in the TRI Open Individual league competition from a large field of entries. The other members of the Borris team were Clonagoose Bouncer partnered by Claire Kavanagh, Longhill Cruising and Patrick Doyle and Caoilfhionn Lawlor on Addigoole Atto. Second place in the team event went the way of Scoil Mhuire trim who was represented by Abu Dhabi ridden by Meabh Lone, Silke and Kate Carroll, Ashmount Clover and Lucy McGovern, and Kilcarty Forward Thinking ridden by Emily Brooks. Third place was claimed by local team St. Kevin's Dunlavin represented by, Lucy Leigh on Monsieur Frederike, Ella Henley on Kelly's Dream and Annaghtown Boy ridden by Ana Tagle. The remaining league points were claimed by Gorey Community School, Dominican College, Wicklow and Newbridge College.

In the Tri Open Individual League competition whilst victory went to Boris's Cathy Doyle, gaining the coveted 10 points in a very well supported class, St. Kevin's, Dunlavin's Ella Henley on Kelly's Dream, put up a great challenge, being only four seconds slower, to claim second place ahead of East Glendalough's representative Anna Morrissey riding Shergar Rose, while Baylee Neville, Ella Kenny and Aibidh Condren came fourth, fifth and sixth respectively.

In the HSI 1.100cm qualifier clear rounds were hard to come by and a beautifully judged clear gave first place to Gorey Community Schools Naomi Doyle on Park Na Ruairc ahead of Aibidh Condren riding Castlebridge Dacquiri in second and Angela McGee in third. Remaining qualifier places went to Megan Neville Claudia Shanahan and Lauren Spencer.

The EII 90cm qualifier was hotly contested and Jamie Brown from Rockwell College on Clear Oxer claimed first place ahead of Sparky Papa, ridden by Charlotte Sexton, also representing Rockwell College and Hugo ridden by Dara Walsh for St Declan's CC, by the slimmest of margins. The remaining qualifying slots went to Harry Barton, Evelyn Fahey and Aoife Flynn respectively.

Isla Coad riding the Wow Cow for St. Saviours won the EII Primary league 75cm class once again ahead of Faithlegg Waterford's Lucy Kent riding Snoopy in second and Whitehall's Blainaid Murphy on Miss Suzie in third. Georgia Keogh from Donard NS made her debut when winning the 55cm class.

The novice 80cm Individual class was open to both primary and novice riders and Lucy McCarthy put in a brilliant effort to win ahead of Mai Monahan and Lily Sullivan. East Glendalough's novice team claimed victory in the Novice team class. The team members were Skyla Malley, Anna Morrissey, Rosie Coad and Sarah Curry.

McCarthy was also a member of the Primary winning team when the hotly contested Primary Team's class went the way of local school Kill National School, who teamed with Dunmore to see off strong opposition from the combined team from St. Mary's NS Bagenalstown and Kiltegan Ns in second and Kildare Town Educate Together and St. Brigid's in third. The winning team members were Luxa, ridden by Emily McCarthy, Clio and Lucy McCarthy, Buddy ridden by David Kent and Lotso and Lucy Kent.
