St Declan's Community School, Kilmacthomas saw off rivals East Glendalough to claim the prize in the **TRI Open Teams league competition**. St Declan's was represented by Belle ridden by Kiera Reilly, Eabha Mansfield riding Rosie, Coolfin Viviendi ridden by Clodagh Shanahan and Gearoid Bolger on Whitethorn Honeys and Rock. The East Glendalough teams consisted of Firebolt and Robert Cherry, Carlstrom Kingcarra Mia ridden by Anna Hudson, Shergar Rose and Anna Morrissey and Carra Cave Boy ridden by Jazmine Arthur. Third place went to the Gorey Community School team of Naomi Doyle on Pairc Na Ruarc, Lauren Spencer on Sparrow, Angela McGee riding Abbeybrooke Aurora and Jessica Murphy riding Ashwood Reggie, with Borris Vocational school, Dominican College Wicklow and St. Gerard's Bray claiming the remaining league points.

East Glendalough's Robert Cherry again riding Firebolt was fastest in the **TRI Open Individual League class** to claim first place ahead of Colaiste Bhríde's Chloe Massey riding Call me Callie, second and Mosey Murphy riding Steven Dee for Borris Vocational School. The EII 90cm novice qualifier class was won by Penny Kelly riding Dunbeggan Dreamer for St. Paul's, Monasterevin; Second place went to Sparkey Pope Winning Gold ridden by Charlotte Sexton representing Rockwell College third to Ciara Sinnott on Bentley for St Mary's New Ross. The remaining qualifying slots on offer went to Maddison Askins, Holly Spencer, Jessica Kinsella and Joe Dunne.

The EII Novice team event produced plenty of excellent jumping and the team from Presentation Secondary school, Wexford were delighted with their win. Jags and Mia Meyler, Bob ridden by Ellen Goggins, Arnie and Grace Kelly, and Eva Mulligan riding Teddy were on that team. The novice St. Declan's team claimed second place. The school was represented by Darragh Walsh on Hugo, Pretty Neat ridden by Lucy Jane Reilly, Quinlan's Crystal and Sarah Jackman and Aoife Lenihan on Dudes Laws. Gorey Community Schools, Holly Spencer on Mischa, Shayna Glynn on Mighty Mouse, Amber Farrell riding Scooby and Mayhall Star ridden by Madison Askins, slotted into third ahead of Loreto Wexford and East Glendalough.

Hazel Slattery riding Breolie Mist from Kilrane NS was the winner of **the primary Individual League class** with The Wow Cow ridden by Isla Coad from St Saviour's Rathdrum in second and Aoife Murphy riding Polly for Our Lady's Island in third.

The journey from Kill in Co Kildare was well worthwhile when the Scoil Bhríde team were victorious in the Primary team class.
